Day 1 Monday

Arrive in Broken Hill

You will be met by your Host from Silver City Tours and escorted to accommodation.

Day 2 Tuesday (LB, D)

City Sights and Heritage Tour – Sunset Sculptures Symposium (9am -1230pm)

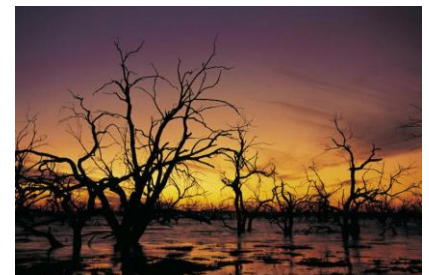
Experience a fascinating tour showcasing the highlights of Australia's First Heritage Listed City. You will visit the Miner's Memorial located at the highest point of the Linde of Lode, gain exclusive access to the Perilya Broken Hill Mine, tour and observe the city's unique architecture. After a short break we head to the World-famous Sculpture Symposium for a sunset. 6.15 pm



Day 3 Wednesday (LB, L, D)

Menindee & Kinchega National Park (9am- 4.30pm) 110kms

Enjoy a leisurely tour around the Menindee Lakes scheme. Travel to Menindee and on to Kinchega National Park (Roads Permitting). Enjoy a Wetlands Cruise on the "River Lady".



Day 4 Thursday (LB, D)

Royal Flying Doctor Service & Silverton Ghost Town (1000-1130 am)

After breakfast we visit the famous Royal Flying Doctor Service. In the afternoon you visit Australia's liveliest ghost town and setting for many movies. See craft centres, galleries and museums, and the historical Silverton Hotel (1.30 -5pm)

This evening, after dinner, we will be enjoying the outback skies with a visit to Outback Astronomy for a "Hanging with the Stars" experience. 8pm





Day 5 Friday (LB, D)

Whites Mineral Art and Mining Museum - Taste of the Artback

After breakfast a unique experience where you can go underground without actually going under! (1030-1130am)

This afternoon you will have the opportunity to discover what Broken Hill is becoming famous for – art, with a tour of some of the local galleries. (1pm- 4pm)

Day 6 Saturday (LB, L) (9am - 4pm)

After breakfast we will be heading off to Mutawintji National Park. The park is located north east of Broken Hill and is rich in Aboriginal history & Culture.

Day 7 Sunday (LB, L, D)

White Cliffs (overnight) depart 8am – 3.5 hrs drive 300km

Today you head to Australia's oldest commercial opal fields. See Australia's first solar power station. You'll visit Red Earth Opal Underground Mine Tour & Showroom, a chance to purchase opals direct from the source. (Overnight White Cliffs Underground Motel) Please note that the hotel does **not** have ensuites. Shared facilities but lock up bathrooms.

- TrainLink Outback Explorer train departs Sydney on Monday morning and arrives in Broken Hill Monday evening. Departs Botken Hill on Tuesday mornings and arrives in Sydney Tuesday evening.
