Day 1 Saturday, June 11, 2016

Those on the *Silver Explorer* will be transferred from the Harbour to your hotel.

After checking in to the hotel, we will meet in the foyer for an afternoon walking tour of Tromsø. You will be taken on a 2 hours walking tour of Tromsø including the Polar Museum.

After breakfast you will enjoy a return trip on the Fløibanen funicular. The Fløibanen funicular railway is one of Norway's most famous attractions. The trip starts from the city centre, just 150 metres from the Fish Market and Bryggen. The trip up to the mountain is a magnificent experience in itself.

From Mount Fløyen, approx. 320 metres above sea level, you can enjoy the beautiful view, study the cityscape in detail and the seaward approaches and fjords surrounding Bergen.



The Funicular takes you to a fantastic area of beautiful natural surroundings with innumerable opportunities for walking and hiking. At Fløyen there is also a restaurant, cafeteria, souvenir shop and play area. The Fløibanen funicular runs daily from early morning until 11 p.m. .

Bergen is "The Gateway to the Fjords of Norway" and a well-established cruise port. An international city packed with history and tradition with small-town charm and atmosphere.

Bergen is surrounded by one of the world's most spectacular tourist attractions - The Norwegian Fjords, which have now been included on UNESCO's World Heritage List.

The old Hanseatic wharf is architecturally unique and is perhaps one of the most familiar image in all of Norway

**Your main luggage will be picked up at the hotel at approximately 06:15
You should pack an overnight bag to take with you till you reach Oslo. This will make your journey easier.**

You will be transferred to the ferry. Enjoy the cruise to Balestrand

Balestrand, an idyllic village on the main Sognefjord with its narrow fjord branches and scenic and lush mountain landscape. Here you will find high mountains, deep fjords and peace and quiet.

Make your way to the Ferry terminal for the Ferry from Balestrand to Flam.

Departs 1150 and arrives 1325

On arrival check in to your hotel which is close to the ferry terminal. Drop off your bags and make your way to the ferry for your scenic return trip.



At 1445 you will board the Gudvangen- Flam return ferry. You will arrive back in Flam at approximately 1900. There is a cafeteria on-board where you can buy lunch.

Today you have an adventure on the railway from Flam to Myrdal to Oslo

The train takes you through the most scenic parts of Norway. You will transfer in Myrdal and continue to Oslo. The train slows down at scenic spots. There will be ample photo opportunities!



Flåm - Only a short walk from your hotel to the railway station

Train ticket 2nd class including seat reservation Myrdal/Oslo

There is free seating on the Myrdal/Flåm train.

Oslo - On arrival to Oslo, it is only a short walk across the road to your hotel. Your main luggage will be at the hotel.
