Madrid shows the multiple contrasts inherited through the History. You will be able to find the medieval origins of the city,

like the Arabic fortress, at the Barrio de la Moreria, characterized by the antiquity of its buildings and the taste of its typical restaurants. We will also cover the Hapsburg Madrid of Felipe II, with its Renaissance and Baroque buildings. Then, we will also see the Bourbon Madrid and the urban layout made by Carlos III, the Royal Palace, (from outside) the Cibeles Fountain, Neptune Fountain and the Puerta de Alcalá. We will also visit the works from the kingdom of Joseph Bonaparte on the 19th century, such as Prado Museum. We will get to know the contemporary Madrid on areas such as Gran Vía, Paseo de la Castellana, Barrio Salamanca, Plaza de Castilla as well as the commercial and financial areas of Modern Madrid and the Santiago Bernabeu Stadium. María la Blanca; Museum Monastery of San Juan de los Reyes; famous technique of Damasquinado (encrust of precious metals in steel) and panoramic sightseeing of Toledo.

Morning departure by private motorcoach to Granada with English speaking guide. Escort to hotel Check-in. Dinner will be at the hotel. Accommodation: *Palacio de los Patos, 5 stars, <u>www.hospes.com</u> Check-in, dinner and accommodation at the hotel.*

Sept. 16th. Tuesday – GRANADA Breakfast included

Buffet breakfast at the hotel.

Morning departure for the full day tour of Granada, visiting the Alhambra and Generalife Gardens, Cathedral, Royal Chapel and walk tour of the Albaycin.

The Alhambra's Islamic palaces were built for the last Muslim emirs in Spain and its court of the Nasrid dynasty. After the Reconquista by the Reyes Católicos ("Catholic Monarchs") in 1492, some portions were used by Christian rulers. The Palace of Charles V, built by Charles V, Holy Roman Emperor in 1527, was inserted in the Alhambra within the Nasrid fortifications. After being allowed to fall into disrepair for centuries, the Alhambra was rediscovered in the 19th century by European scholars and travelers, with restorations commencing. It is now one of Spain's major tourist attractions, exhibiting the country's most significant and well known Arab-Islamic architecture, together with 16th-century and later Christian building and garden interventions. The Alhambra is a UNESCO World Heritage Site,



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and the inspiration for many songs and stories.^[] Cathedral of Granada Albayzin:The Albayzín (or Albaicín) is a neighborhood of Al-Andalus origin, much visited by tourists who flock to the city because of its historical associations, architecture, and landscape. Sept. 17th.Wednesday- GRANADA/RONDA/ARCOS DE LA FRONTERA/SEVILLA, 380 KMS.

Breakfast and dinner included

Buffet breakfast and Dinner at the hotel.

Morning departure by private motorcoach with English speaking escort to Ronda, upon arrival you will have a guided tour including inside a visit to the famous bullring.

Ronda is situated in a very mountainous area about 750 m above mean sea level. The Guadalevín River runs through the city, dividing it in two and carving out the steep, 100 plus meters deep El

Tajo canyon upon which the city perches. The Spanish Fir (Abies pinsapo) is endemic to the mountains surrounding Ronda.

Bullring. Soon after the ring's creation in the 18th century, the Romero family of Ronda emerged to provide over three generations of bullfighters. The most important of them was Pedro Romero (1754-1839), a key figure in the history of bullfighting who slew more than 5,600 bulls. The Romero and Ordóñez families were known for their great bullfights in the Plaza, and a statue of Cayetano Ordóñez stands outside one of the entrances to the bullring.

Arcos de la Frontera is a town in the province of Cádiz in southern Spain. It is located on the eastern bank of the Guadalete river, which flows to the Bay of Cadiz. The town commands a fine vista atop a sandstone ridge, from which the peak of San Cristobal and the Guadalete Valley can be seen. The town gained its name by being the frontier of Spain's 13th century battle with the Moors.

The Royal Andalusian School of Equestrian Art Foundation with the exhibition regarded as the best equestrian ballet in the world: "How the Andalusian Horses Dance". An authentic equestrian ballet with choreographies based on the Traditional and Cowboy Methods of Taming Wild Horses, and genuine Spanish music and XVIII century customers.

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After the show, we will have lunch in a local restaurant and continue to one of the famous Sherry wine cellars with sherry tasting.

Still surrounded by the old walls it is a World Heritage Site by UNESCO and will attract you for its medieval appearance, the narrow streets, the historic centre and the kindness of the locals. Amongst several interesting monuments, you shall not miss the Roman Temple from the 1st century, unique of this kind in both Portugal and Spain. This is also the perfect place for a great gastronomic and wine experience, as this is one of the regions in Portugal with more traditional and quality at this level. You shall not miss the opportunity of having a meal in one of the city's restaurants.

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22nd September – Evora breakfast


24th September – Breakfast included Belmonte

Hotel check-out and departure to Quinta da Ervamoira, private visit, wine tasting and lunch. Panoramic drive along the Douro and board a luxury river cruise ending in Pinhão. Upon arrival to Pinhão please join a special wine tasting of some special Port & Chocolate tasting at the CS Vintage House. **Douro Valley** is where the terraced hill slopes hide one of the country's most valuable treasures: the beautiful vineyards from where the worldwide famous Port wine is still nowadays produced. Driving through Marão Mountain range get prepared to enjoy one of the most wonderful landscapes in the world, with endless rows of vines dotting the slopes in the banks of the Douro River. We advise you to visit one of the wineries in the region and taking a river cruise.

26th September – Breakfast and lunch included Guimares

Hotel check-out and visit of Mateus Manor House. Arrival to Guimarães and included lunch in a traditional restaurant. Visit of Guimarães in the afternoon.

Guimarães is the cradle of Portugal as this is where our first king, Afonso Henriques, was born and where he began the nation. You shall not miss the visit of the Ducal Palace, the Castle and walking along the narrow streets of the historic centre (declared World Heritage Site by UNESCO) till the charming Praça da Oliveira (Oliveira Square).

27th September – Breakfast included

Full-Day Private Tour to Braga and free time for lunch in the afternoon in the center of Braga. Return back to the town of Guimarães for a free afternoon for some shopping.

28th September Guimares to Porto Breakfast included

Departure to Porto .Full-Day Private Tour of the city with free time for lunch.

Porto is at the same time the name of a city and a fortified wine, one of the most famous in the world, aged at the wine cellars of Vila Nova de Gaia, next to the Douro River. Its historical center has been declared a World Heritage Site by

UNESCO and preserves many beautiful monuments, namely from the Baroque period which is contemporary to the glory and wealth achieved with the trade of Port Wine. You shall not miss a visit to the Cathedral (Sé), the Church of Saint Francis and the Clérigos Tower.

29th September Breakfast included Porto

Free day in the city of Porto.

Or

Optional tour for those who would like to go to Viana do Castelo and Ponte de Lima (This is already included in tour cost)

Viana do Castelo is one of the most beautiful towns of Minho. Don't miss a visit to the Sanctuary of Santa Luzia with an incredible view over the Atlantic and the town. In the historical center the narrow streets with its small churches will lead you into lively town squares that are a lovely place to walk around. You may also admire the filigree handmade works in one of the small shops in town.

Ponte de Lima is located at the banks of the Lima River. It's considered the most ancient village in Portugal, for having been given charter in 1125 by the mother of our first king. With a beautiful historic centre there are a large number of manor houses and palaces. In Ponte de Lima you can take the chance to enjoy a genuine cuisine and the locally produced Vinho Verde (green wine).

Accommodation: Porto at Hotel Pestana Porto.

30th September Breakfast and lunch included. Porto to Obidos

Departure to Coimbra and visit of the University. Lunch included in Nazaré. In the afternoon visit of the medieval town of Óbidos.

Accommodation: Óbidos at Pousada de Óbidos.

Óbidos is for sure one of the loveliest medieval villages in Portugal, still surrounded by walls and whose traditional whitewashed houses are decorated with blue and yellow trims around doors and windows. The multicolored flowerbeds decorating the houses prove the female touch in this village that used to be the wedding gift of our kings to their queens.

1st October – Breakfast and lunch included Obidos to Sintra to Lisbon

Free time in the morning in Óbidos and departure to Sintra.

Lunch is included in a regional restaurant in Sintra.

Visit of the town of Sintra and departure to Lisbon along the Estoril Coast.

Lisbon, capital of Portugal, located at the mouth of the Tagus River and from where the Portuguese boats set sail overseas in the 15th and 16th centuries

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towards East. At that time, the Maritime Discoveries period, the city became the centre of a large empire, still visible in the monuments of Belém section. Well known for its historic traditional neighbourhoods you'll be amazed with the sections of Chiado, Bairro alto and Alfama as well as the Castle of Saint George and the gorgeous views you can enjoy from the top of its hill. If you prefer modernity, you can also go to the newest section of the city, the Nations Park, the former world exhibition of 1998 area. Nowadays this area is considered one of the safest and well attended of the city of Lisbon.

Full-Day Private Tour of Lisbon including visit of Lisbon's Synagogue and Jewish quarter. In the afternoon private tram ride on traditional "Eléctrico" tram in old quarters of Lisbon. Free time for lunch in Lisbon.
